Pretend you are the President of the United States. Write down a list of 5 rules you think all Americans should follow.	Go on a scavenger hunt inside or outside. Find 5-10 items and place them in a bag. Compare the texture of each object.
Find an old magazine and scissors. Search and cut out words. Use the words to make new sentences!	Find a recipe for a cake or cookies. Practice measuring the correct amount of ingredients. Bake and enjoy!	Make a map showing the design of a new playground for our school. Include a title, compass rose, and map key!	Go on a scavenger hunt inside or outside. Identify 5 things that move by pushing and 5 things that move by pulling. Draw and label items on a piece of paper.
Do you like e-learning at home or learning at school? Pick one and write reasons why!	Find 5 objects in your room to "purchase" at a pretend store. Use note cards or post-its to make price tags for each item. Grab some coins and count out the amount you need to buy each item!	Pick any place that you would like to go on vacation to. Track the weather in that city for a week. Compare it to the weather in your hometown!	Draw and label pictures of things that can be used to protect yourself from the sun's harmful rays. How are animals able to protect themselves from the hot sun? Write response on paper.
Record yourself reading your favorite book (or a chapter) with expression. Try to use a different voice for each character!	Use your knowledge of time to create a daily schedule and follow it!	Think about 5 special events that have happened in your life. Put them in order and make a timeline of your life!	Choose an animal and illustrate its life cycle. Be sure to have at least 4 phases.
